This non-credit 63 weeks course includes the fundamentals of learning medical terminology to more advanced study of anatomy & physiology with its applicable terminology. Includes an in-depth study of the major body systems and medical specialties along with various diagnostic studies and procedures. Student will then learn the presentation and application of basic coding rules, principles, guidelines, and conventions utilizing various coding systems. The student will learn to accurately code procedures and diagnosis, abstract information from health records for appropriate code validation, and apply decision-making skills to ensure proper sequencing. Prepares students for future certification and various types of coding positions.
